WHO MAY ATTEND

- * Active Y.O.U. (High School Age—grade 9th—12th)
- * In order to attend a regional rally, teens must be “active” in his/her Y.O.U. Chapter at church. Active” means that the teens attend Sunday Y.O.U. at least 2 times per month for 2 months prior to rally. Must be in good standing with church.
- * Adult Leaders ~ at least one adult traveling with teens must be a minimum age of 25.
- * ALL adults attending must have a background check on file at his/her church.
- * Adults & Teens must be able to honor Heart Agreements & attend entire weekend from check-in Friday through Closing Circle Sunday. **No exceptions.**
- * Teens with special challenges requiring close, personal adult supervision should be accompanied by a parent or guardian who will not be responsible for the rest of the group

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- * Check-in: Wednesday, June 14th from 7:00pm—midnight
- * Rally begins with breakfast, Thursday June 15th at 9:00am with Opening Celebration following and ends by noon on Sunday. Check-in location will be sent closer to event.
- * Only adults may carry cell phones in the off/silent setting. *If a teen or adult is unable or unwilling to honor the spirit of the Retreat and the Heart Agreements, he/she may be sent home at the expense of the parent/guardian or sponsoring ministry.*

WHAT TO PACK

- * Sleeping bag or sheets & blanket, pillow, towels, toiletries, personal items, sunscreen, Jacket, long pants, shorts, sandals, close-toe shoes, bathing suit & coverup. (Please read Heart Agreement for appropriate/accepted clothing.)
- * Alarm clock, flashlight, bug spray, sunscreen, flip flops are ok for showers
- * Medication will be given & dispensed to/by Head Sponsor/ Med Staff.
