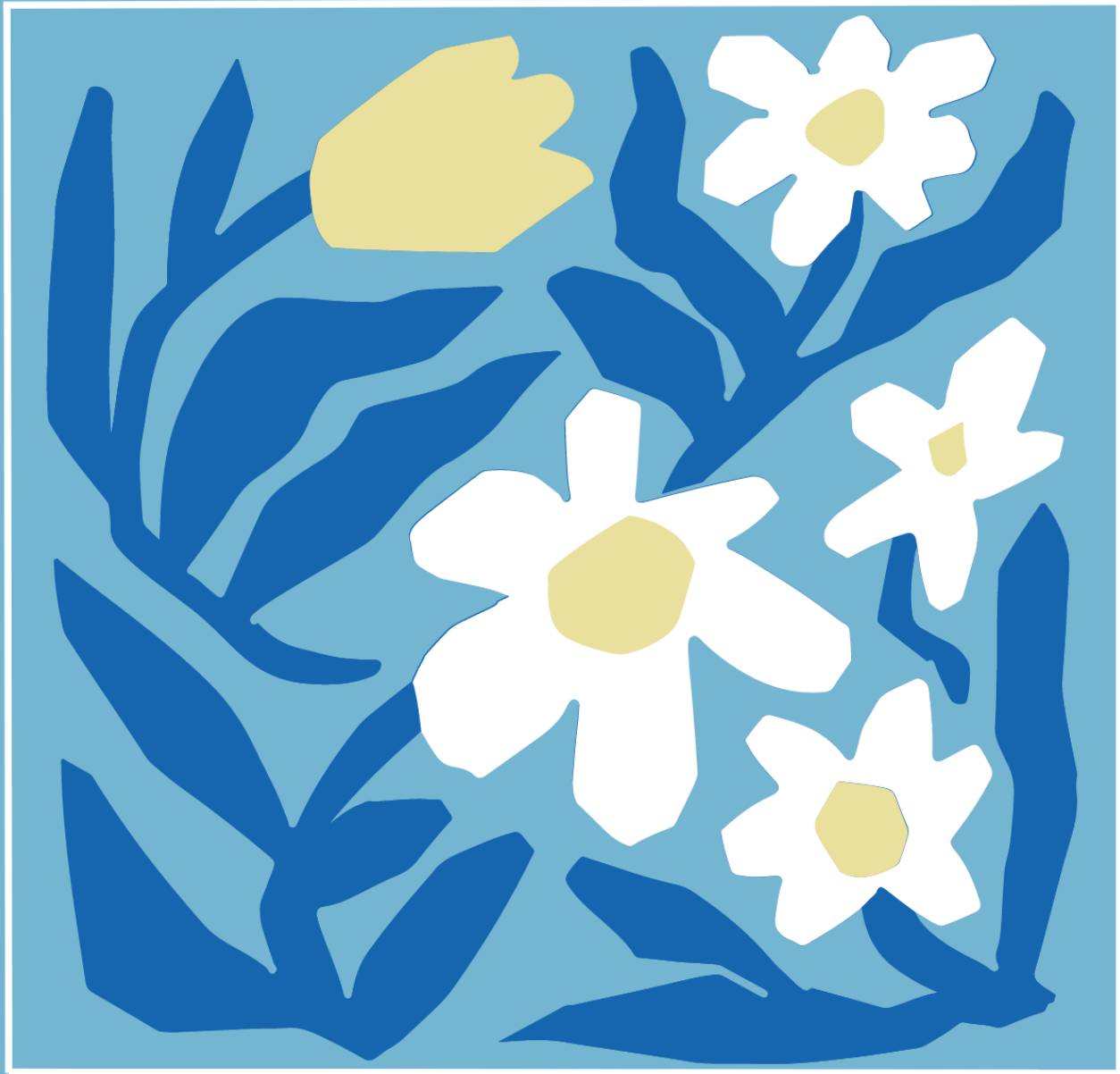

WHO MAY ATTEND

- * Active Y.O.U. teens(9—12th grade) & sponsors.
- * Adult Leaders ~ at least one adult traveling with teens must be a minimum age of 25.
- * ALL adults attending must have a background check on file at his/her church.
- * Adults & Teens must be able to honor Heart Agreements & attend entire weekend from check-in Friday through Closing Circle Sunday. **No exceptions.**
- * Teens with special challenges requiring close, personal adult supervision should be accompanied by a parent or guardian who will not be responsible for the rest of the group

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- * Check-in: 4:30pm - 5:00 p.m at TBD
- * Dinner begins at 5:00pm—5:30pm. Everyone needs to be Present
- * Rally begins Friday, promptly at 5:35 p.m for Opening Celebration and ends by 12Noon on Sunday.
- * Only adults may carry cell phones in the off/silent setting. Teens will access to phones at night only

If a teen or adult is unable or unwilling to honor the spirit of the Rally and the Heart Agreements, he/she may be sent home at the expense of the parent/guardian or sponsoring ministry.

WHAT TO PACK

- * Sleeping bag or sheets & blanket, pillow, towels, toiletries, personal items, bug spray, Jacket, long pants.
- * **Close-toe shoes** must be worn at all times
- * Alarm clock, flashlight. Flipflops ok for showers
- * All Medication for teens/adults must be given to Med Staff for dispensing at check-in. Exception: inhaler, epi-pen or birth control.

No electronic devices.
